Spots and rooms are filling up fast, so if you're planning to make reservations.

There are a few fees changes this year for lodging. Please note these changes below:

- Tent/RV sites (no hookups) = \$80 total
- RV sites (110v plugin & access to water) = \$120 total
- RV sites (30amp plugin & access to water) = \$160 total
- Dorm rooms = \$160 total

There are currently 12 RV sites with 30-amp plugins. If you have already reserved a campsite, Laryssa from the Conference will be in touch regarding whether you have access to the 30-amp plugin or not - it will be based on the order in which the sites were reserved.

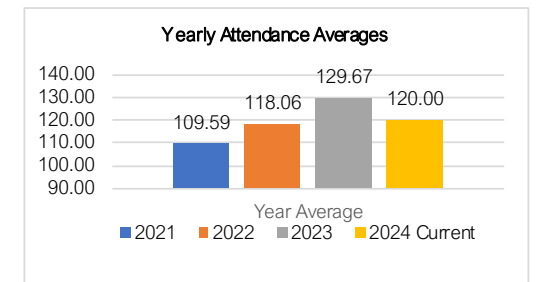

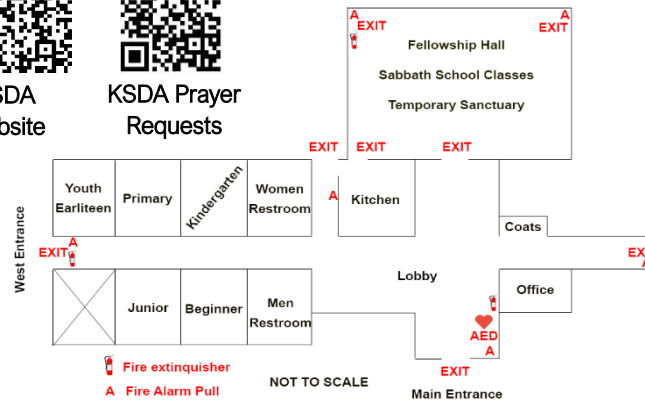
